Introduced by Council Member Freed; also Council Members Castaneira-Colon, O'Donovan and Robinson.

A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Washington Street, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Washington Street	Western Union International Plaza	from Battery Place to Morris Street

§ 2. This local law shall require the change in this street name to be indicated on the city map.

§ 3. This local law take effect immediately.
