CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] All right.

Good morning and welcome to the Committee on Land

Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, Chair of

this Committee. I would like to welcome my esteemed

Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been

joined by Deputy Speaker Ayala, Council Member Moya,

Chair Riley, Majority Whip Brooks-Powers, Council

Member Abreu, Majority Leader Farías, Chair Hanks,

Council Member Hudson, Council Member Sanchez, and

Minority Leader Ariola.

Today, we are voting on three proposals referred to us by our Subcommittees. As always, I

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would like to thank Chair Riley and Chair Hanks for their ongoing leadership.

I want to note that the following items that had originally appeared on today's agenda are being laid over and will not be voted on today. LU-414 for the 2149 Pacific Street Article XI request and Proposed Intro. Number 958-A. These items will be voted on a future meeting and now for our votes.

First, we will vote to approve with modifications LUs numbers 426 and 427 regarding the MTA's 125th Street and Lexington Avenue rezoning proposal in Deputy Speaker Ayala's District. The proposal includes a zoning map amendment and related zoning text amendment which together will facilitate the development of a new mixed-use building with approximately 680 dwelling units, up to about 170 of which would be permanently affordable above the future terminus of Phase 2 of the 2nd Avenue Subway in East Harlem. Our modifications will be to rezone a portion of the subject block to a C6-4 district while the remainder would be mapped with a C6-11 district to facilitate the MTA development. Deputy Speaker Ayala is in support of the application as modified.

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We will also vote to approve the two applications under the City's Walk to a Park initiative brought by the Department of Parks and Recreation together with DCAS seeking combined site selections and acquisition approval of privately owned properties for potential future parks development in underserved areas. We will approve LU 420 in Brooklyn District 5 in Council Member Nurse's District and Banks' District in Brooklyn and LU 421 in Queens Community District 3 in Council Member Cabán, Krishnan, and Moya's District in Queens. All the affected Council Members are in support of the respective proposals.

Now I would like to recognize any of my Colleagues who would like to give remarks or have questions.

Seeing none, I will call for a vote with the support of the local Council Members to approve with modifications LUs 426 and 427 for the MTA and 125th Street and Lexington Avenue Rezoning Proposal; and to approve two Walk to Park site selection acquisition actions including LU-420 for Brooklyn Community District 5 and LU-421 for Queens Community District 3.
