**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a street name, Cus D'Amato Way, Borough of Manhattan.  
Be it enacted by the Council as follows:**

**Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.**

Cus D'Amato Way	14th Street	the south side of 14th Street between 4th Avenue and Irving Place

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
