Proposed Intro Number 1160-A would require that the Department of Transportation, where practicable, ensure that pavement markings or temporary pavement markings are installed on a street within five business days of street resurfacing. The Department will be required to report on their performance, including the number of streets where paving markings have been installed, the percentage that were completed on time, and if there were delays and the reason for the delays.
