All right. Good morning, and welcome to the Committee on Land Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, chair of this committee.

I would like to welcome my esteemed colleagues who have joined us today. We've been joined by Council Member Moya; Chair Riley; Brooke-Powers...

I'm sorry, Majority Whip Brooks-Powers; Majority

Leader Farías; Chair Hanks; Council Member Hudson;

Council Member Sanchez; and Council Member Narcisse.

As always, I would like to thank Chair Riley and Chair Hanks for their work on leading our two subcommittees. Today, we are voting on two items referred by our Zoning Subcommittee.

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We'll also approve the modification of the of LU Numbers 208 and 209 for the 2185 Coyle Street Rezoning Proposal in Council Member Narcisse's district in Brooklyn.

The proposal includes a Zoning Map Amendment and related Zoning Text Amendment, which together will facilitate a mixed-use residential building in Sheepshead Bay with over 400 apartments of which between 20 and 25% will be permanently affordable.

The Council's modification will reflect the actual height of the proposed building and help it show consistency with recent rezoning in the area.

A modifications will modify proposal R7A to an R6A district and a proposed R7X to an R7D district.

We are also modifying to remove MIH Option 2 and add deep affordability option.

Council Member Narcisse supports this proposal as modified. And we will recognize Council Member Narcisse to give a brief comment on her project.

COUNCIL MEMBER NARCISSE: Thank you, Chair Salamanca, and all of my colleagues here.

It's about time. I'm so happy for the project. We are in a crisis, but the modification is needed because we don't want to build out of character at

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the same time. We want to respect our community, especially when we engage, uhm, Community Board 15.

All the groups were very engaged, and that's, uhm, their quest, their request, I should say.

So I'm happy to be here and say, yay! We have, some units to our city, because I know some of my colleagues complain that not everybody is doing their parts, and I'm happy to do my part. So, yes, thank you so much for your support, guys.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Congratulations, Council Member.

Today we will also vote to approve the modifications LUs 210 and 211 related to the 438 Concord Avenue Proposal in Deputy Speaker Ayala's district in the Bronx.

The proposal includes a Zoning Map Amendment and a related Zoning Text Amendment, which would facilitate a mixed-use residential building in the South Bronx with approximately 87 apartments of which 24 would be permanently affordable. A modification would to remove MIH Option 2 and add deep the affordability option. Deputy Speaker Ayala is in support of the proposal as modified.
