A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a park name, Clement Clarke Moore Homestead Park, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following park name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Clement Clarke Moore Homestead Park	None	an existing triangular shaped park bounded by Broadway on the east, 45th Avenue on the south and 82nd Street on the west.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
