**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a street name, Lenox Avenue/Malcolm X. Boulevard, Borough of Manhattan.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present Name	Limits
Lenox Avenue/Malcolm X. Boulevard	Lenox Avenue	from W. 111th Street to W. 145th Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
