A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Harry Suna Place, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Harry Suna Place	22nd Street	between Queens Plaza South and 43rd Avenue

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
