TITLE: A local law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York in relation to creating population limits for adult shelters

SPONSOR: Council Member DiBrienza

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: This legislation would amend the administrative code in order to clarify that although local law 57 establishes a maximum of 200 beds at adult shelter facilities, any shelter which as of last June (June 1, 1998) was operating with a census exceeding the 200-bed limit may continue to operate with a census above the 200-bed cap.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This legislation is effective retroactively to December 17, 1998.
