A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, William "Bill" Sicklick Place, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
William "Bill" Sicklick Place	Pitt Street	between Broome Street and Grand Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
