A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Natalie Crossman Place, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Natalie Crossman Place	226th Street	between Merrick Boulevard and 130th Avenue

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
