A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a sidewalk name, William Cooper Walk, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following area name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
William Cooper Walk	(none)	the sidewalk on the south side of Queens Boulevard between 64th and 65th Roads

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
