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**SLR 0018-2003** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Maltese, S.1776, and Assembly Member Nolan, A.3934, "AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Queens to Theodore M. Renz, sole heir-at-law and distributee of former owners Rudolph Renz and Johanna Renz".
