A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Police Officer Francis X. Walsh Street, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Police Officer Francis X. Walsh Street	West 171st Street	between Amsterdam Avenue and Audubon Avenue

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
