A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a corner name, Pamela Mascaro Corner, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following corner name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

Pamela Mascaro Corner	none	The southeast corner of 76th Road and Austin Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
