A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Avenue of the Strongest, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Avenue of the Strongest	Worth Street	between Broadway and Centre Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
