A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Philip D'Adamo Place, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Philip D'Adamo Place	Middagh Street	between Henry Street and Hicks Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
