A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a triangle name, Irving Schloss Triangle, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following triangle name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Irving Schloss Triangle	(none)	an existing triangle located within the intersection of Neptune Avenue, East 12th Street and Guider Avenue.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
