My name is Kamillah Hanks and I am the Chair of the Committee on Public Safety, and I'd like to welcome you to our vote today on Proposed Introduction Number 756A and Proposed Introduction Number 439A. I'd also like to recognize my fellow Council Members, Council Member Williams, Stevens, Brannan, Ariola, Bottcher, Joseph, De La Rosa, Cabán, and Holden. Proposed Introduction Number 756A, sponsored by myself, requires the Office for Neighborhood Safety and the Prevention of Gun Violence to provide training and operational support to nonprofit service providers participating in the City's Crisis Management System. I am also very excited that Proposed Introduction Number 439, sponsored by Council Member Nantasha Williams, requires the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice to evaluate the performance of criminal justice programs that receive funding from the City. And I believe thse two pices of legislation will strengthen the City's delivery of criminal justice services which
