Int 0833-2000 A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the inclusion of Gold Star Parents for purposes of eligibility for the alternative exemption for veterans from real property taxation in accordance with section four hundred fifty-eight-a of the real property tax law.

Int 0834-2000 A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the real property tax exemption for persons with disabilities whose incomes are limited due to such disabilities.

Res 1625-2000 Resolution authorizing the filing of applications for state assistance payments for municipal recycling projects within the City of New York and the signing of the associated state contract under the appropriate laws of New York State.
