A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Lieutenant Thomas A. Williams Place, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Lieutenant Thomas A. Williams Place	(none)	the south side of Queens Boulevard between 64th Street and 65th Street

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
