A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, West 122nd Street-Seminary Row, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
W. 122nd Street-Seminary Row	W. 122nd Street	Area of a street between Amsterdam Avenue and Claremont Avenue.

Section Two. This local law will take effect immediately.
