A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a repeal of a plaza name, Gulf and Western Plaza, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following plaza name as enacted by local law 85 of 1968 is hereby repealed.

New name	Present name	Limits
none	Gulf and Western Plaza	the triangular area bounded by West 61st Street, Central Park West, Broadway and Columbus Circle

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
