The purpose of this hearing is to hold a vote on two bills. Proposed Intro. Number 498-A, sponsored by myself, in relation to requiring an application from Community Gardens to request collection of organic waste by the Department of Sanitation, and Proposed Intro. Number 1126-A, sponsored by Council Member Yusef Salaam, in relation to requiring the provision of official waste

COMMITTEE ON SANITATION AND SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT 3 containers at no cost to serve residential buildings with two or fewer dwelling units, and providing for the repeal of such local law upon the expiration thereof. The Committee heard previous versions of Proposed Intro. Number 498-A and Proposed Intro.

Number1126-A at a hearing on November 20, 2024, where it received testimony from representatives of the Department of Sanitation, environmental advocates, and other interested members of the public.

Proposed Intro. Number 498-A will require
DSNY to make available on its website an online
application allowing Community Gardens to request
curbside collection of organic waste. DSNY would be
required to collect organic waste from Community
Gardens that request such collection beginning on
August 15, 2025. As we work to increase our organics
capture rates citywide, it's imperative that we make
it as easy as possible to access this service.

Next, Proposed Intro. Number 1126-A would require DSNY or other administering agency as designated by the Mayor to distribute official New York City waste bins to owners of eligible buildings. This bill would also require DSNY or the administering agency to establish and implement a

1 COMMITTEE ON SANITATION AND SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT 4 2 program to reimburse owners of eligible buildings who 3 purchased official New York City waste bins on or before August 1, 2026. Eligible buildings include 4 those with up to two dwelling units where the building owners enrolled in a New York Star or 6 7 Enhanced Star Tax Benefit Program. DSNY or the administering agency would be required to submit a 8 report on the law's implementation one month after the law's expiration. 10 11 I would like to thank everyone on my team and in the Legislative Division for their work on 12 13 this legislation. 14 I will now turn it over to the Clerk to 15 take the vote on Proposed Intro. 498-A. Are there members on the Committee, is 16 17 Yusef on, who would like to speak to his bill? 18 COUNCIL MEMBER GENNARO: I would just like 19 to do a sound check, make sure people can hear me.
