A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a park name, Seaman First Class Radioman Joseph Manna Park, Borough of Staten Island.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following park name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

Seaman First Class Radioman Joseph Manna Park	(None)	area bounded by Forest Avenue, Forest Avenue and Goethals Road North
