A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Reola Belfield Way, Borough of The Bronx.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Reola Belfield Way	East 163rd Street	between Trinity Avenue and Rev. James A. Polite Avenue

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
