A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Cable Way, Borough of Staten Island.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New Name	Present name	Limits
Cable Way	Goodrich Street	From its intersection with South Avenue westerly to its point of termination.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
