Ari Halberstam Memorial Ramp	(none)	the southerly entrance ramp to the Brooklyn Bridge beginning at the merger of the FDR Drive and Pearl Street at Gold Street, and continuing to the merger with the Park Row entrance to the Brooklyn Bridge
