Now, I would like to invite the sponsor of the legislation, Council Member Cabán, to provide remarks.

COUNCIL MEMBER CABÁN: Thank you, Chair Louis, Members of the Committee. I'm proud that today, during Pride, the Council is ready to pass Resolution 817, legislation I'm honored to cosponsor, along with the LGBTQIA Plus Caucus and Chair Louis. This resolution calls on the New York State Legislature to fund and protect gender-affirming care, medical care that is essential, evidence-based, and lifesaving. At a time when the federal government is launching an all-out assault on the rights, safety, and bodily autonomy of transgender and gender-nonconforming folks, this Council is standing firm in our values. The Trump Administration's executive orders and its campaign to strip access to medical care is not just anti-science. It is cruel, discriminatory, and dangerous. With the passage of this resolution, we're sending a clear message. We won't allow our transgender neighbors to be targeted
