A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Christopher Santora Place, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Christopher Santora Place	33 rd Road	between 21 st Street and 23 rd Street

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
