A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a triangle name, Matthew S. Turner Triangle, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following triangle name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Matthew S. Turner Triangle	none	a triangular area located at the intersection of St. Nicholas Avenue and Frederick Douglass Boulevard between West 120th and West 121st Streets.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
