My name is Lincoln 15 Restler, and I have the privilege of serving as the 16 Chair of the Committee on Governmental Operations 17 State and Federal Legislation. 18 I would like to start off by thanking my 19 Colleagues who have joined us today, Brooklyn's own 20 David Carr, Queens' Jim Gennaro and Lynn Schulman, 21 and the Upper West Side's Gale Brewer. Online, we 22 have Council Members Ina Vernikov, Jennifer 23 Gutiérrez, and Shahana Hanif. Thank you all for being 24 with us. 25

Today, we'll be voting on four State 2 3 Legislative Resolutions, also known as Home Rules or 4 SLRs, in support of various State legislation. One of these SLRs deals with an issue that many of my 5 Colleagues hear about from our constituents on a 6 7 constant basis - dirty streets. This legislation 8 would allow New York City to equip street sweepers 9 with cameras to enforce illegal parking during alternate side parking periods. Under this State 10 11 legislation proposed by Assemblymember Brian 12 Cunningham and State Senator Robert Jackson, 13 violators would be fined when captured on camera by Department of Sanitation street sweepers similar to 14 15 existing bus lane camera enforcement that fines vehicles parked in bus lanes through cameras on MTA 16 17 buses. Each street sweeper or broom picks up a 18 literal ton of debris per shift. It's really quite 19 extraordinary. But these street sweepers can't get 20 the garbage in our communities if they can't access 21 the curb. This policy will make our streets 2.2 demonstrably cleaner and reduce the presence of rats 23 in New York City. And I want to recognize Council Member Brewer for introducing a resolution here in 24 25 the Council in support of this legislation as well.

COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS, STATE AND FEDERAL LEGISLATION 4 1 2 We are also voting on an SLR to ensure that traffic enforcement agents receive pension 3 4 credit for their service as TEAs if they later become police officers. Traffic enforcement agents have one 5 of the hardest jobs in City government. They work 6 7 long hours in all seasons to keep pedestrians safe and keep traffic moving, and they deserve credit for 8 9 their years of service. The other SLRs we will vote on today 10 11 cover additional requirements and death benefits for 12 various City employees that I am pleased to be 13 supporting. I'd like to wrap up by saying thank you 14 15 to the Council Staff who work on our Home Rules, 16 Santa Soriano-Vasquez (phonetic) and Rick Arbelo 17 (phonetic) for their terrific work this season on 18 Home Rules. Really appreciate it. And I want to thank our Committee Staff, Jayasri Ganapathy and Erica 19 20 Cohen for their hard work. And lastly, my Chief of 21 Staff, Molly Haley and Communications Director Nieve 2.2 Mooney, who are superb. 23 With that, I'll now ask the Clerk to call the roll. 24

COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Thank 13 14 you. 15 COUNCIL MEMBER PALADINO: Hi, Lincoln. 16 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Following 17 results. All SLRs have been adopted by the Committee 18 with nine in the affirmative, zero in the negative, 19 and no abstentions with the exception of SLR 2 being 20 adopted by the Committee with six in the affirmative, 21 three in the negative, and zero abstentions.
