FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

COMMITTEE: Children and Youth

TITLE: A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to the structure and responsibilities of the youth board

SPONSOR(S): Council Members Stevens, Fariás, Brooks-Powers, Williams, Avilés, Louis, Brewer, Encarnación and Banks

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: Int. No. 448-A would implement term limits for youth board members and would reduce the amount of board members from 28 to 20, 10 of whom would be appointed by the Mayor and 10 of whom would be appointed by the Speaker of the Council. Additionally, the board would be tasked with providing policy recommendations to the Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD). DYCD would then be required to submit a report to the Mayor and the Speaker of the Council responding to each recommendation submitted by the board.
