**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a corner name, Sergeant Finbar Devine Corner, Borough of Manhattan.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section 1. The following corner name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Sergeant Finbar Devine Corner	(none)	the southwest corner at the intersection of Varick Street and Ericsson Place

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
