A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Quisenbury Drive, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Quisenbury Drive	Gregory Place	a street located between Baltic Street and Butler Street, approximately 190 feet west of 5th Avenue.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
