Introduced by Council Member Berman (by the request of the Mayor).

A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to increasing the annual license fee for wholesale cigarette dealers.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision g of section 11-1303 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local law number 34 for the year 1987, is amended to read as follows:

1. The annual fee for a wholesale cigarette dealer's license shall be [five] six hundred dollars, and the annual fee for a retail cigarette dealer's license shall be ten dollars.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately and shall apply to licenses issued or renewed for a term beginning on or after February 1, 1992.
