Proposed Intro No. / Title: *Int. 1056 / Training for medical personnel in public schools and reporting on participation in such training*

Committee: Health

Summary of Legislation: This legislation requires the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) and the Department of Education (DOE) to provide mandatory annual competency training on health concerns related to sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, and sex characteristics. The training must be provided to department-employed or department-contracted medical personnel stationed in public school facilities. Additionally, DOHMH must submit an annual report detailing the number of DOHMH-employed and DOHMH-contracted medical personnel trained, and the number of DOE-employed and DOE-contracted medical personnel trained.

Effective Date: 120 after enactment
