The Council's FY26 budget includes 84.7 million
dollars for personal services and 30.3 million for
other-than-personal services, or OTPS. Next, we have
a pre-considered Article XI resolution that would
authorize a full 40-year exemption from real property
taxes for BFH Housing Development Fund, BRC Cluster 3
in Council Member Stevens' District. It consists of
three buildings comprising of 189 rent-stabilized
units restricted to 60 percent or below AMI, area
median income. Finally, we have a pre-considered
resolution that would authorize a full 40-year
exemption from real property taxes for BNR Cluster
Housing Development Fund in Council Member
Gutierrez's District. It consists of one building
comprised of three rent-stabilized units with a
target AMI of 60 percent.
