A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a park name, **Keith L. Williams Park, Borough of Queens.**

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following park name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Keith L. Williams Park	Liberty Park	an existing park bounded on the north by Liberty Avenue, on the east by 173rd Street and the west by 172nd Street

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
