18 This morning, we'll be voting on Intro
19 422-A, sponsored by Council Member Rivera. This bill
20 would require the Department of Information
21 Technology and Telecommunications to create a
22 separate 3-1-1 category for rooftop activity
23 complaints, and would require the Department of the
24 Commissioner of Buildings to submit an annual report
25 regarding certain rooftop spaces.
