COMMITTEE: State and Federal Legislation

Title: AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to health insurance coverage for surviving domestic partners of members of the police department and the fire department who are enrolled in a health insurance plan.

SPONSORS: Council Member Foster

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: Provides that when a retired member of the fire or police department in the city of New York dies and is enrolled in a health insurance plan, the surviving spouse or eligible domestic partner, until he or she dies, shall be afforded the right to such health insurance coverage; such plans include premerger retirees who were police officers employed by the New York city housing authority or the New York city transit authority.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would take effect immediately.
