Summary of Legislation: This bill would require the Department of Transportation (DOT) to annually post a description of all projects planned for that year. This posting must occur concurrently with the submission of DOT's annual streets plan update. Additionally, DOT must provide monthly updates on the progress of each project, including: status, the actual and estimated start and completions dates, community board presentations, if applicable, project funding, and whether cost overruns or delays have occurred.
