A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Msgr. Francis J. Dillon Place, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Msgr. Francis J. Dillon Place	150th Place	between 17th Avenue and the eastbound service road of the Cross Island Parkway

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
