A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a corner name, Joseph Doherty Corner, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following corner name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Joseph Doherty Corner	(none)	the northwest corner of the intersection of Pearl Street and Park Row

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
