A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a square name, Drumgoole Square, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following square name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

Drumgoole Square	none	an existing sitting area located at the intersec- tion of Frankfort and Gold Streets, approx- imately 90 feet on the west side of Gold Street and approximately 250 feet on the south side of Frankfort Street.
