A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a playground name, Vito P. Battista Playground, Borough of Brooklyn.
Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following playground name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New Name	Present name	Limits
Vito P. Battista Playground	none	an existing playground within Highland Park located on the north side of Highland Boulevard between Bulwer Place and Heath Place

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
