A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Sister Mary Irene Fitzgibbon Corner, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Sister Mary Irene Fitzgibbon Corner	(None)	the southeast corner at the intersection of Avenue of the Americas and West 17th Street

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
