SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good afternoon and welcome to the New York City Council vote of the Committee on Land Use.

At this time, can everybody please silence your cell phones.

Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] All right, good afternoon and welcome to the Committee on Land Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, Chair of this Committee. I would like to welcome my esteemed Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been joined by Council Member Moya, Rivera, Chair Riley, Majority Whip Brooke-Powers, Abreu, Majority Leader Farías, Hanks, Hudson, and Sanchez.

Today, we will be voting on a number of items recommended to us by our Zoning Subcommittee and, as always, I would like to thank Chair Riley and Chair Hanks for their ongoing leadership.

Today, we will vote to approve LUs 132 through 136, relating to the MSK Pavilion Project in

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Council Member Menin's District in Manhattan. As
Chair Riley described in detail at our Subcommittee
vote, this project includes five related land use
actions, which together will facilitate the
development of a new state-of-the-art hospital
facility dedicated to advancing MSK's mission against
cancer and associated diseases by providing muchneeded capacity for new patient and surgery space
within MSK's existing Upper East Side Campus. We will
approve a revocable consent, a Zoning Text Amendment,
a Zoning Map Amendment, a Zoning Special Permit, and
the cancellation of a restrictive declaration.

We will also vote to approve LU 154, related to an application by Seis Vecinos seeking a revocable consent to operate a sidewalk cafe located in my District in the Bronx.

We will also vote to disapprove LU 155, related to another sidewalk cafe application for Cozy Corner in Council Member Holden's District in Queens. The Zoning Subcommittee voted earlier today on this application, following a statement on the record by Council Member Holden detailing the many concerns he has raised throughout this process.

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We will also vote to approve LU 137, related to a 150 Mill Street rezoning proposal in Council Member Avilés' District in Brooklyn. The proposed Zoning Map Amendment will facilitate a new manufacturing and office development.

We will also vote to approve two preconsidered land use applications regarding 2390

McDonald Avenue rezoning proposal in Council Member

Yeger's District in Brooklyn. The proposal includes a

Zoning Map Amendment and a related Zoning Text

Amendment to facilitate the development of a new

mixed-use building with approximately 80 units,

approximately 24 of which will be permanently

affordable.

Are there any questions or comments from Members in the Committee?

Seeing none, I now call for a vote with the support of the local Members to disapprove LU 155 for the Zoning for the Cozy Corner sidewalk café, to approve LUs 132, 133, 134, 135, and 136 for the MSK Pavilion, LU 137 for the 150 Mill Street rezoning, LU 154 for the Seis Vecinos sidewalk café, and preconsidered LUs related to the Zoning Map and Zoning Text Amendment for 2390 McDonald Avenue rezoning.
