A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a park name, Columbus Park, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following park is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Columbus Park	(NONE)	An existing park located adjacent to the Supreme Court building for the County of Kings bounded by Johnson Street, Cadman Plaza West, Court Street, Joralemon Street and Adams Street.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
