Summary of Legislation: This legislation authorizes the following increases for business improvement districts (BIDs) at the start of city fiscal year 2027: the Myrtle Avenue BID to \$660,000; the Woodhaven BID to \$425,000; Pitkin Avenue BID to \$500,000; Hub Third Avenue BID to \$700,000; Bryant Park BID to \$4,000,000; Kings Highway BID to \$650,000; Court-Livingston-Schermerhorn BID to \$2,400,000; Fulton Mall special assessment district to \$4,000,000.
